Dear all

A lot of people have been asking about how I came to make my West End stage debut, so here's MY story:

"Last November I was sent a copy of 'TOMMY' the Broadway musical CD and script to see if I was interested in auditioning for the part of 'Mrs Walker' - Tommy's mum. I was immediately interested in the project as Tommy was an album Dad had in his collection when I was ten and I loved listening to it then. I was very nervous about the audition as I've never done one before and was surprised to see Pete Townsend there as well as the director Des McNuff. I performed Mrs Walker's songs and felt quite confident, although less so when I had to read my lines. Anyway they phoned the next day to say I'd got the part, by which time I was in New York making a video for 'This I Swear'. Pete Townsend sent me a wonderful fax encouraging me to take the part and Des phoned me at the hotel to invite me to a production of his on Broadway called 'How To Succeed in Business' starring Matthew Broderick. Not really being a theatre goer I had no idea what to expect. I was blown away by the acting, singing, direction and production. I knew I HAD to work with this man



who made it all come to life so magically. So that was that, my mind was made up. Rehearsals were hard going; six days a week in Acton, London. I was terrified on the first day when everyone first got together. We all sat around tables going through the script and singing all the songs. On reflection it was such a magical time, all of us getting to know each other, working with Des McNuff and Pete Townsend. Fantastic. I soon got into the swing of things and felt comfortable with everything. By the opening night came I was completely ready for it, feeling excitement rather than nerves and fear. We all worked together as a team and other members of the cast have completely supported me. My dressing room at the Shaftesbury Theatre is adjacent to Paul Keating's who plays the part of 'Tommy'. It's strange watching him becoming very famous - he's 20, more or less the same age

as I was when I became famous. He works very hard and I've become very fond of him, he calls me 'treacle!!'. Doing 8 shows a week is quite hard going sometimes, although I look forward to every performance. I get a buzz seeing the photograph stills of the musical outside the theatre. I can't believe it's really me!! Perhaps I'll do some more acting, I'm definitely open to that prospect.

I'm making another record for release soon, it's a cover of an old 70's disco tune. Strange thing is I first got the idea to do this particular song from seeing it on the juke-box on the stage for Tommy (it's in the youth club scene!!). I'm very excited about it. I'm also making plans to do a radio show once a week with a friend of mine which will be a lot of fun. So life is very busy and very good. I'm extraordinarily happy and know I made absolutely the right decision to do Tommy. It has been lovely to meet so many of you at the theatre I'm glad you all seem to

The money that was raised is to go to charity and although at the very beginning we (Kim and the Fan Club) had intended to give all the money just to one charity, we have decided that it would be a lot nicer if we distributed the money to various charities, especially the ones that Kim is involved with. Roxanne and I had such a fabulous day and hopefully so did everyone who was there. Who knows if this will become an annual event.

Articles for the Fan Club Auction

We met early 1993 and Martin had this idea to organise a Kim Wilde Fan Meeting, something that had never been done before. In July 1995 we proposed the ideas to Nick and Melanie, where we were given permission. After lots of letters, faxes and phonecalls the meeting started to take shape. Melanie suggested she'd like to attend the meeting and stage an auction. In October 1995 Marcel visited the Select Sound Studios and in November Martin followed suit to discuss things, and to see the first batch of very impressive auction items!!

Marcel took care of public relations whilst Martin arranged the venue - Cafe Riche in Breda, Holland. On Sunday 10 March 1996, the meeting actually happened. We were there at 9am to make the final arrangements, while fans were already lining up - from Holland, France, England, Germany and Belgium; an international fan meeting!! At 11am the meeting officially started with some great items to be bought and swapped from fans and dealers. Everyone seemed to enjoy meeting other fans and watching the videos with many different TV clips. At 12.45 our special guests from England arrived with the auction materials. Our publicity campaign, meanwhile, resulted in a visit from a reporter and photographer from a local newspaper which led to a great article and photo in Monday's edition of Breda's 'De Stem'.

At 2pm the Kim Wilde quiz started. The questions proved to be pretty testing covering various aspects of Kim's career. In the final round Arnould Tousain and Roberto Kappen battled against each other, but after some tie-breaker questions Roberto was pronounced winner.

The next event to take place was the auction. The stack of items was virtually inexhaustible. Early fan club magazines, special recordings, personal photographs, promotional material, original artwork, Kicki's 1986 tour jacket, Marty's 1994 tour jacket and Kim's hat which went for amazing prices. The highlight was of course the auctioning of Kim's dress, which she wore on the cover of the 'Love Is' album. Daan Joziasse and Adrie Rombouts, bid against each other at £100 a time. Daan finally bought it for an amazing £900. It was a spectacular ending of a very successful and enjoyable day.

Overall the meeting was a big success and we'd like to thank the people that assisted us on the day. The people from Cafe Riche, Ramona de Ruij, Melanie and Roxanne for being with us and staging the auction and especially Kim Wilde, without whom this event would never have happened. We're happy to have been able to raise so much money for the charities of her choice. We feel very honoured, proud and privileged to have been able to organise the FIRST EVER Kim Wilde fan meeting, on 10 March 1996 in Breda, Holland. No matter how many meetings there are going to be in the future, there will never be a FIRST time again!

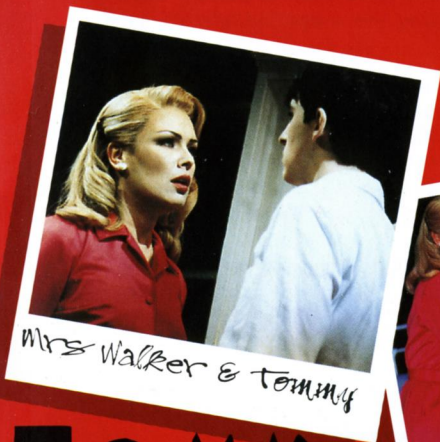

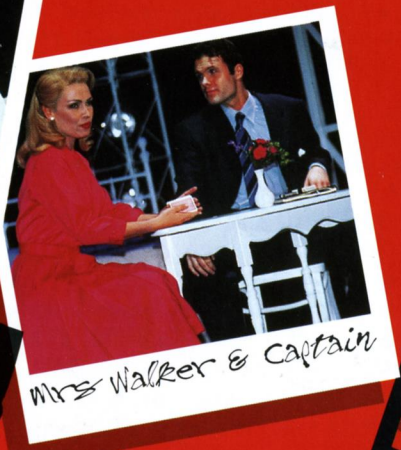

1994 was the year Kim Wilde toured the world with her Greatest Hits Concerts. I decided that this was my opportunity to meet my favourite star.

As she had several dates in Germany I knew that I'd have the chance. On the 4 June, Kim played in Leipzig. The show was great with a huge audience attendance. After the concert had finished Kim did not have much time to sign autographs, but I couldn't give up. I decided to look for the hotel where Kim and the band were staying. Eventually I found it and decided to get to the hotel very early in the morning to catch Kim. I waited in front of the hotel the following morning for a while and then Kim came out. She was alone, so I had a great chance to speak with her. I showed her my membership card and my ticket; both of which she autographed. She then got on the tour bus for the next destination - Berlin. I attended several other concerts for that tour, all of which I had the chance to speak to Kim after the show.

But Leipzig was the first personal contact I ever had with Kim - it was an unforgettable moment in my life.

Patricia Mine - France

I met Kim for the first time on 11 June 1986 in Paris. I waited at RTL from 7.00am. Kim arrived at 14.00pm for an interview to promote her new single Schoolgirl. When I saw her my legs were like cotton wool - I keep telling myself 'it's not possible'. When I spoke to her I could only manage 'Hello Kim'. She replied 'Hello' back with a large smile. I went off to a cafe before returning to hear the interview. The manager told me that Kim would be doing another interview at Canal + (French TV). In the evening I went to Canal + and gave Kim the chocolates I'd bought earlier for her: she loved them. The second meeting with Kim was on 7 June 1991 in Paris again. I had drawn a picture of Kim which I had intended to give to Kim but she kindly autographed it for me and so it now hangs in my home with pride. I met Kim again on the 28 February 1996 at TOMMY. I waited outside the stage door for an hour and a half before Kim finally came out. I kissed her and she asked where I'd come from, I answered 'France' and she said 'Ah Paris!!'. I showed Kim my Fan Club card, which she kindly autographed. I explained to her that I had come to London just to see her, Kim then took my arm so we could be photographed, she was very nice to us (Gaëlle and I). A man then came and he said to Kim 'Hey Kim it's time to go' and with that Kim replied 'Au Revoir'. I can't wait to meet Kim again as every time I see her she is so sympathetic and kind.
