I'm sure you've all been happy with the exposure which Kim has enjoyed surrounding the promotion of "If I Can't Have You" and "The Singles Collection 1981-1993".

The album is doing really well throughout Europe, and its current chart positions at the time of writing follow, along with its highest position in each territory:

Austria 10 (26), Australia 17 (17), Belgium 29 (29), Denmark 43 (46), Finland 19 (5), Germany 24 (21), Holland 6 (6), Sweden 19 (28), Switzerland 10 (28), United Kingdom 11 (11).

The new single is, IF MY LIFE, which most of you will recognise as the bonus track on "The Singles Collection". The track has been remixed by Ricki and Pete Schreier and by West End who have recently enjoyed success with their mixes for Dina Carroll and Sybil, amongst others. This will be released throughout Europe on Monday 29th October and in the UK one week later, on the 1st November on the following various formats:

Kim has recently been promoting "If I Can't Have You" and "The Singles Collection" in Australia, and is presently doing the same in Japan. The hard work is certainly paying off in these countries and everyone is really knocked out with the success of both releases there. Kim will return to London on Monday 29th October, where she will have two days before going off to do more TV's etc in Germany, Finland and Denmark! Our UK members will be delighted to learn that Kim will be co-presenting Channel 4's ~~new~~ ~~documentary~~ for the week commencing 8th November. I know Kim is really looking forward to the show, and if you don't want to miss out, then set your alarm clocks and take it between 1am and 9am every morning - it should be a lot of fun!

Other UK TV's to look out for in the next couple of weeks are, "Family Affairs" and "Peeble Hill". There are a couple of others in the pipeline but are, as yet, unconfirmed.
