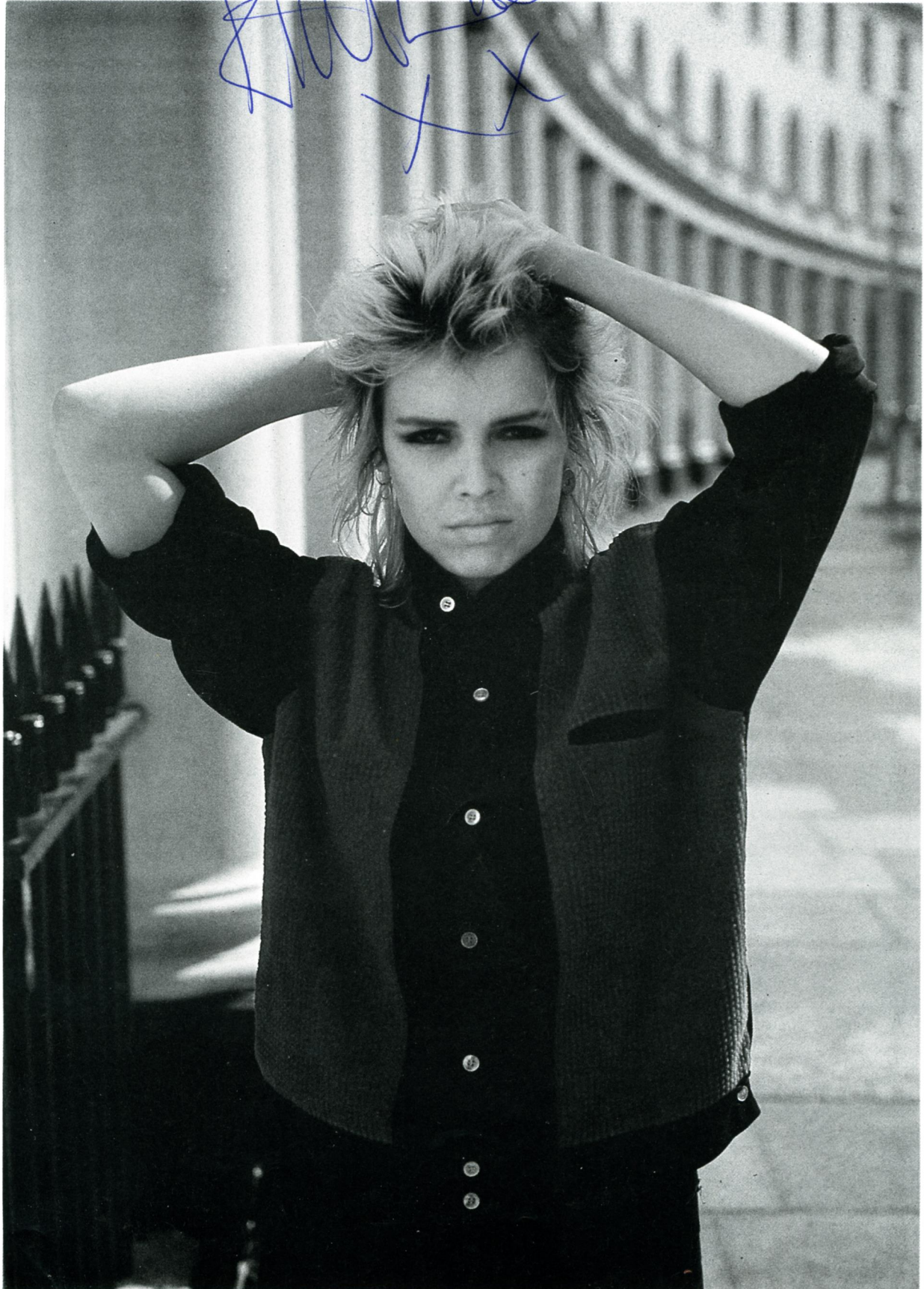


Kim Wilde Fan Club News

Welcome to Newsletter Number 6, the last one for the first year. Many of you will have been with us since the start and will hopefully have gained an insight into the work of a successful recording artiste. During the past year we have sent membership packages to two thousand people and have still managed, in our opinion, to maintain a certain closeness with many individuals.

Although the response from fans was not as good as we had hoped, we have decided to continue the fan club for a further year largely because most of you who have promised to rejoin were so adamant that it should continue.

As suggested in the last Newsletter, the subscription fee will be £3.50 for the UK and £6.00 for overseas fans. Membership will last from September 1st 1982 to the end of August 1983 and during that time you will receive four Newsletters at regular intervals. The reasons for the reduction in Newsletters was explained in the June Issue but we can assure you that the standard won't drop.

If you would like to rejoin, please fill in the form on the back page of this magazine and send it to us along with a cheque or Postal Order for £3.50 (UK only) or an International Money Order or Eurocheque for £6.00 (overseas members) and enclose your membership card for stamping up to date. Please enclose a large SAE. You will receive a 10"x8" glossy photo of Kim when your membership card is returned, but please allow 21 days for your re-subscription to be processed.

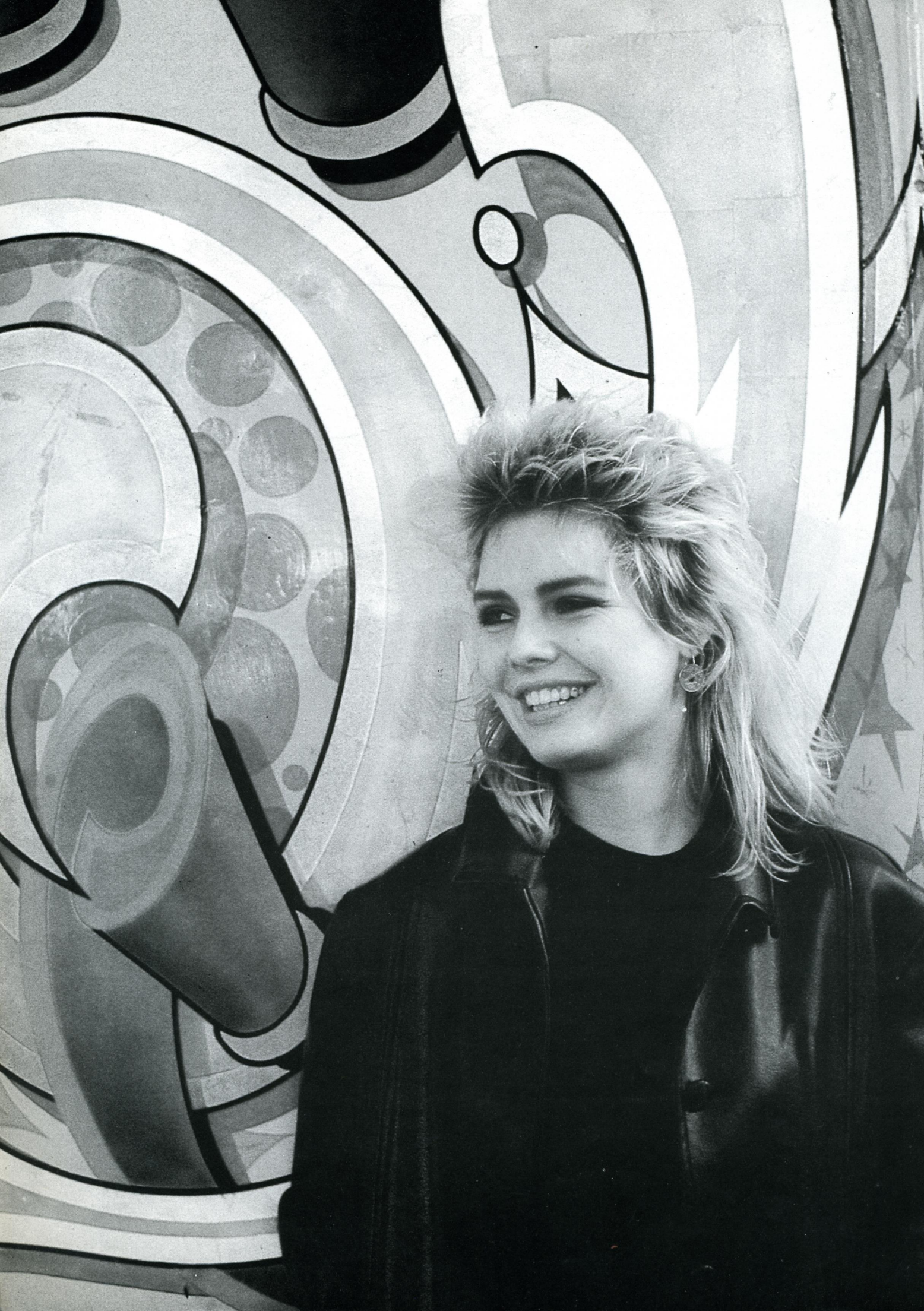

Many members were puzzled by the fact that they received less than six sticky labels with their membership packages. This was because the labels were used for each Newsletter sent to you and therefore late joiners only received the number of labels required for the number of books left to be issued.



Record News

Keep your eyes and ears open for a new single – as yet untitled – in four to six week's time. Kim has recorded a few track records and its just a question of picking the right one.

With regards to the rest of the world, both view from a bridge and select have climbed the charts in most countries and are on their way down. "select" reached the top ten in Germany, Sweden, Holland, Denmark, Australia and others. In France, Cambodia has now sold over one million copies which represents a platinum disc and the amazing thing is that it's still selling.

The news is also good from America where the first album and kids in america are still climbing the charts. Some of yoy may of heard the Paul Gambaccini u.s. chart show which is now beginning to feature Kim and at the time of going to print, the single is at 23 and the album 86 in the billboard chart which is the most influential.

Kim's Travels

In mid-September, Kim will have to take a break from tour rehearsals to visit France and Germany for a couple of television shows before returning to the U.K. to take to the stage.

There is a possibility that Kim will be doing some live dates in Scandinavia as a warm up to the British tour – possibly Norway, Denmark or Sweden.

Once the U.K. is under her belt the likelihood is that Kim will take the live shows elsewhere in the world so she may be off your screens for quite a while after October.

When Kim was guesting on Roundtable, there was a "Nationwide" film crew in the studio to film the show for future transmission. Apparently, nationwide are doing a news feature on the music business and Roundtable was an aspect that they were interested in. We do not know when it is going to be screened other than it is going to be in September so it might mean that you will have to watch Nationwide every night for four weeks – still it will be worth it???

Tour Details

This is the best news we have had for ages. At last we can give you some positive information regarding Kim's debut tour. Kim is doing an extensive U. K. tour in October, comprising 19 dates all over the country. You've had to wait a long time to hear this but I know it's going to be worth it.

The tour dates, listed below with the box office telephone numbers should give most of you the chance to see Kim, but if it is impossible for some of the fans then Kim would like to apologise it's just that she has to draw the line somewhere.

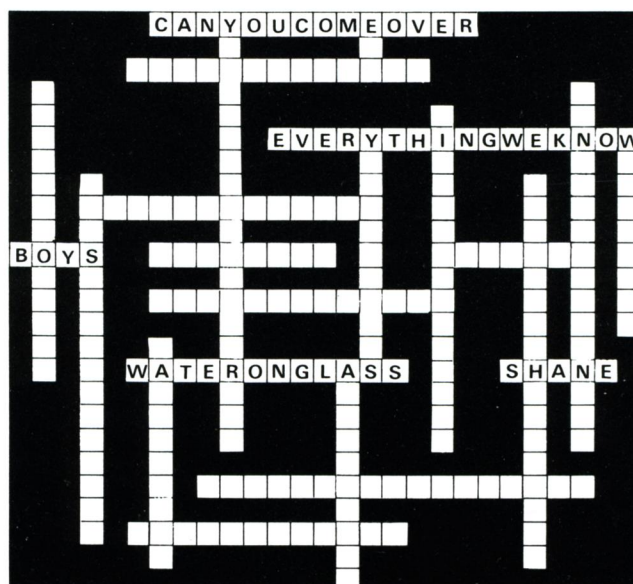

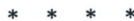

After a very long time, we eventually found the musicians we wanted and with the band complete started our rehearsals.

At the time of writing this, we're all taking a break (only for five minutes). It has all come together incredibly quickly and sounds great. I'm very excited about doing the tour, as are the band, and look forward to seeing as many of you as possible. Of course in between all of this activity we've been recording for a new single to coincide with the tour. We hope to go on a short European Tour before we start the UK Tour – this will make sure we're *really* good once you get to see us!

Whilst preparations for the tour have been going on, a team of cameramen have been filming our progress for a short documentary which they tell us will be shown on New Year's Eve about 5.00; we'll let you know more about that nearer the time.

So, I hope to see as many of you as possible on the tour, I really look forward to that – and I hope you like the next single too!
