
# CIMMILDE




## COMPETITION WINNER



As I write this Kim is about to go on stage in Brussels for the first show of her 'Catch '83' European Tour! Sitting at home, we can only imagine the excitement, but for the 1800 fans packed into the theatre the atmosphere will be for real. I just wish we could all be there with her on this, her big night.

By the time you read this, some of you will have been lucky enough to have seen her at one of the fifteen venues covering nine countries. Those of us who couldn't can only envy you! But you never know what 1984 will hold and Kim is sure to be touring again soon.

This time round she's going to Brussels (Mechelen) in Belgium, Lyon and Paris in France, Basle and Lausanne in Switzerland, Vienna in Austria, Utrecht in Holland, Hamburg, Offenbach and Dusseldorf in Germany, Copenhagen in Denmark, Stockholm and Karlskoga in Sweden and finally Helsinki and Oulu in Finland.

Kim's taking a six piece band and a massive PA system that will ensure that everyone hears everything clearly, something that's very important, especially when she's playing venues which hold seven, eight and even nine thousand people! The power of the PA system is actually 18,000 watts and, when you consider that most home hi-fi stereo units are about twenty watts, you can imagine how much power it has and how good the sound should be!

We will be preparing a 'Tour Special' for the next Newsletter with lots of information and photos - perhaps we'll be able to give you a bit of an insight into just what it's like to live 'on the road' for a month, but I'm sure that most of you realise it's no holiday!

Kim's brother, Ricki, isn't playing live with Kim on this tour, because he's too busy with the new recording studio which is just about to be finished. You may have read about the studio in the press, but for Ricki and Kim it's like a dream come true. It's quite staggering how much time and effort goes in to building a recording studio, and just how many qualified experts are needed. We're going to try and sneak our way into the studio in the next couple of weeks and if we do you'll see photos and be able to learn much more about it in the next Newsletter.
