After the huge international chart success of 'You Keep Me Hangin' On' comes the follow-up single, 'ANOTHER STEP (CLOSER TO YOU)', set for release on the 16th March in the U.K. and has just been released in Europe.

The song (which is the title track of Kim's current L.P.) is a duet featuring Junior, and was written by Kim and guitarist Steve Byrd.

The B side, 'Hold Back' was written by Ricki and Marty, and produced by Ricki and Reinhold Meil. Those of you who were in the fan club last year will remember that Reinhold also co-produced 'Schoolgirl' which was released as a single in Europe last summer and, of course, also features on the album.

## Rick's Letter

Hi

Just a quick note to tell you how the new single ('Another Step') came to be.

It was written by Kim and Steve Byrd (Kim's Lead Guitarist) and, as you probably know, is the title track of the album.

When we did the demo of the track, Steve sang the duet with Kim, but we all felt that it needed more of a soul feel vocally. We chucked a few ideas around and came up with the idea of doing the duet with a great singer by the name of Junior. We phoned him up and asked if he was up for it, and of course he said yes - thankfully.

So Junior came up to the studio and we recorded the song in about three days. It was a great experience, and a great time was had by all.

When we recorded the track, none of us realised that it was going to be the next single. When the decision came to be that it was, I decided that, for a single it needed to be 'beefed' up a bit. I kept the vocals and a couple of overdubs, but recorded all the rest using a computer keyboard called Fairlight. I think it now sounds a lot more like a hit - fingers crossed.

I WOULD PERSONALLY TURN A BLIND EYE TO THE ODD BADGE OR POSTER HOWEVER I GET ANGRY WITH BOOTLEG RECORDS AND TAPES. IT IS A HIGHLY ORGANISED RACKET AND CREAMS OFF HUGE PROFITS AT THE EXPENSE OF PERFORMERS, RECORD COMPANIES AND POTENTIAL NEW TALENT ALIKE. IT IS NOTHING LESS THAN GRAND THEFT, AND DOES NOTHING AT ALL TO INDUCE RECORD COMPANIES TO REDUCE RETAIL PRICES FOR US ALL.

Soon after Kim's return from her promotional tour of Japan and Australia, 'You Keep Me Hangin' On' went to number one down-under! It also made the number one spot in Norway too. Pretty good eh!

In January, Kim took part in the Midem Prestige Gala which took place in Cannes in the South of France. She has appeared at Midem in the past, but this year was pretty special. Kim and a host of other stars such as James Brown, Al Jarreau, and Rose Royce (to mention a few) were there this year to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the invention of the record, and the 40th year of the invention of the L.P.

Another main event that recently took place was the BPI Awards, that is the British Phonographic Industry Awards. It is the most important event in the British Music Industry and is watched by millions of viewers throughout the world. Kim was asked to present the award to the winners of the Best British Group of 1986 (Five Star), and was also nominated, once again, for the Best Female Artist award. This was the third time Kim has been nominated. The first time was in 1982 (when she actually won the award), and the second time was in 1984. Unfortunately, she didn't win it this year, that honour went to Kate Bush, but we are all proud of the nomination, and obviously thrilled for Kate.

Kim is set to go off to the United States for the first couple of weeks in March to promote 'You Keep Me Hangin' On' and the album, which have only just been released over there. Wouldn't it be nice if we had a number one there too!

As you now know, 'Another Step (Closer To You)' is the follow-up single to 'Hangin' On'. It's been re-recorded and now sounds even better than it did before! Let's hope we can take another step into the top of the charts with this one!

Look after yourselves, and keep your fingers crossed for another big hit single and album.
