

"HEY MR HEARTACHE" is to be the first single from Kim's new album. The song was written by Kim and Steve Byrd and will be released in the United Kingdom on the 3rd of May. The single has only just been released in Europe. The B side is a song

called "Tell Me Where You Are", written by Kim and Ricki.

As well as being released on 7" and 12", there will also be a CD single of "Hey Mr Heartache", which will include "Tell Me Where You Are", "You Keep Me Hangin' On" and "Another Step (Closer To You)". For those of you wanting to order your copies from record shops now, the catalogue numbers are:

"Hey Mr Heartache" is due for release in the USA and Canada later in the year, so we will keep you up to date as and when we hear more news.



The title of the new album is "Close" and, although we don't yet have a release date, it's expected to be in early June.

The album comprises ten tracks in total, of which eight are

"Wilde" compositions (ie Kim, Ricki and Marty), but it also includes a cover of a beautiful Todd Rundgren song called "Lucky Guy" and, of course, the Kim and Steve track. There will also be a bonus track (Hey Mr Heartache 12") on the cassette and CD formats.

The album is due for release in Europe on the 20th May, and the catalogue numbers for this are:

MELISSA GALLO (FRANCE)

Q How did you get involved in performing backing vocals on "Turn Back The Clock" by Johnny Hates Jazz?
