



This was issued as a blue "Flexi-disc" in a RUSSIAN magazine, "KPYSO3OP 10/88" (i think thats the way to spell it!). The magazine has flexis by other artistes, 6 in total, and had a 3/4 page article and pic of KIM. Unfortunately, i can't translate, any volunteers!!

Once again, value is difficult, probably around £12 / £15, but more with the complete magazine.

After a great show at the DOMINION ON 27th OCT, Kim went on to France, and completed the tour in great style. I know Kim enjoyed the tour as much as we all did, and hopefully will continue touring for many years to come.
